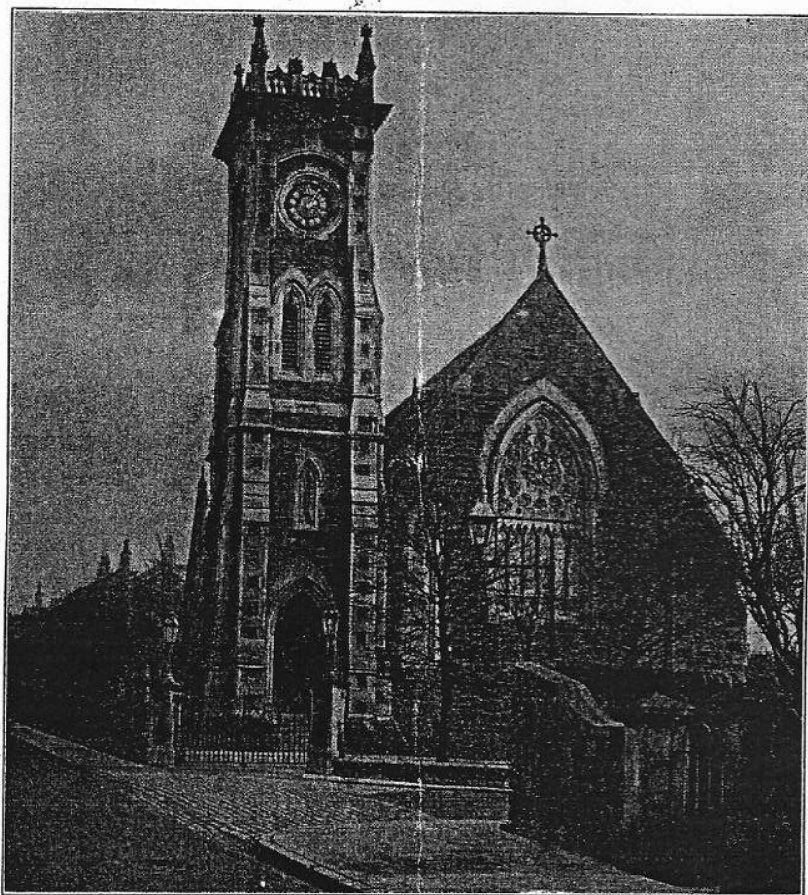

Objects of Bazaar.

THE Object of this Bazaar is to raise Funds for the Enlargement and Improvement of Newport Parish Church, the obtaining of an Organ and Erecting of a Manse.

The necessity for the Enlargement of the Church has for some time been apparent. All the sittings in the Church are let, and several families cannot procure sufficient sitting accommodation. The population of the Parish is steadily increasing, and all the circumstances of the Congregation fully justify the present movement.

The Congregation have for some time been desirous of having an Organ to assist in the Service of Praise. There was no place, however, where it could be erected, and as the need for Enlargement was beginning to be felt, it was considered desirable to postpone the introduction of an Organ till a suitable place could be provided for it. In the plan which has been prepared for the enlargement of the Church, a suitable Organ Chamber is provided at the side of the Chancel.

No Parish Church is fully equipped without a Manse, and many members of the Congregation feel that the erection of a Manse has been too long delayed. A site contiguous to the Church has been feued for many years, and it is now proposed to erect a Manse thereon.

The sum required for the whole scheme is about £4,500. Excluding the money already contributed by the Congregation, and the Grants expected from the Home Mission and Baird Trust, a sum of £2,500 is still required, which it is hoped will be raised by the Bazaar.

The Members of Newport Church are personally doing all they can to ensure the success of the Bazaar, but they feel that for an object so important, they may appeal to outside friends to help their efforts. Newport is a place of growing importance, where it is most desirable that the Parish Church should be well equipped, and where the style of the Church and all the accessories of worship should be in keeping with the character of the place.

Contributions in Work or Money will be gladly received by the Rev. Dr Fraser, Minister of the Parish; by the Ladies whose names appear as Stall-Holders or Receivers of Work; and also by the Bazaar Committee.
